






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Action taken report on the Students Feed back of the DEPARTMENTS



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Department of Microbiology



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Department of Biotechnology and Genetics



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Department of Computer Science/ Electronics





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Department of Mathematics



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Department of Commerce



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Department of BA



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Department of English



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Department of Languages




















10. On time and no rescheduling of classes









13. Sincerity of the teacher




